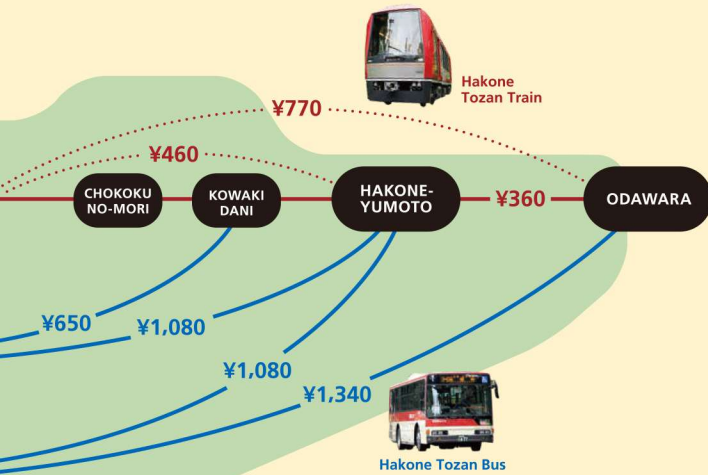

## Transportation in Hakone

Hakone's wide range of transportation services includes the train and cable car that run through the mountains, the ropeway in the sky, and sightseeing cruises on the lake. Visitors always enjoy nature as one of the amusements during their stay in Hakone.



### Hakone Tozan Train

This train runs between Hakone-Yumoto and Gora. Passengers can enjoy seasonal nature along the mountain ride. The train is famous for its switchback railway, which is needed for the steep inclines.



### Hakone Tozan Cable Car

This cable car operates from Gora to Sounzan. The cable car line is surrounded by forest, allowing riders to experience the scenery year-round. From mid-June to mid-July, hydrangeas bloom along the route.



### Hakone Ropeway

This ropeway connects Togendai and Sounzan. During the ride, you will get a great view of Lake Ashi and Mt. Fuji (weather permitting). Owakudani, a popular sightseeing spot, is accessible from the ropeway.



### Hakone Sightseeing Cruise

Approx. 25-40 minute sightseeing cruise from Togendai to Hakonemachi-ko/Motohake-ko. 3 different pirate ships navigate the waters of Lake Ashi! Catch the grand view of both Mt. Fuji and the laketop torii gate of Hakone-jinja shrine while on board!



### Hakone Tozan Bus

This bus runs on a route that links major Hakone destinations, like the Venetian Glass Museum, The Hakone Open Air Museum, and Hakone Kowaki-en Yunesun. You can also use this bus to reach Gotemba Premium Outlets®.



### Tokai Bus

The Tokai Bus departs from Hakone and goes to the Izu Peninsula. Get to Mishima Skywalk from Hakonemachi-ko in 15 minutes. Visitors with Hakone Freepass can use buses between Motohake-ko and Mishima Station free of charge.



### Odakyu Highway Bus

This convenient highway bus operates between Shinjuku Station, Gotemba, and Hakone. Riders can use a line that links Shinjuku to Gotemba Premium Outlets® as well.



### Romancecar

The Romancecar is an Odakyu limited express train with reserved seating only. It links Shinjuku with the popular holiday spots of Hakone, Enoshima and Kamakura, areas loved by tourists from Japan and overseas. Travelers can appreciate the view from the wide windows during the ride.

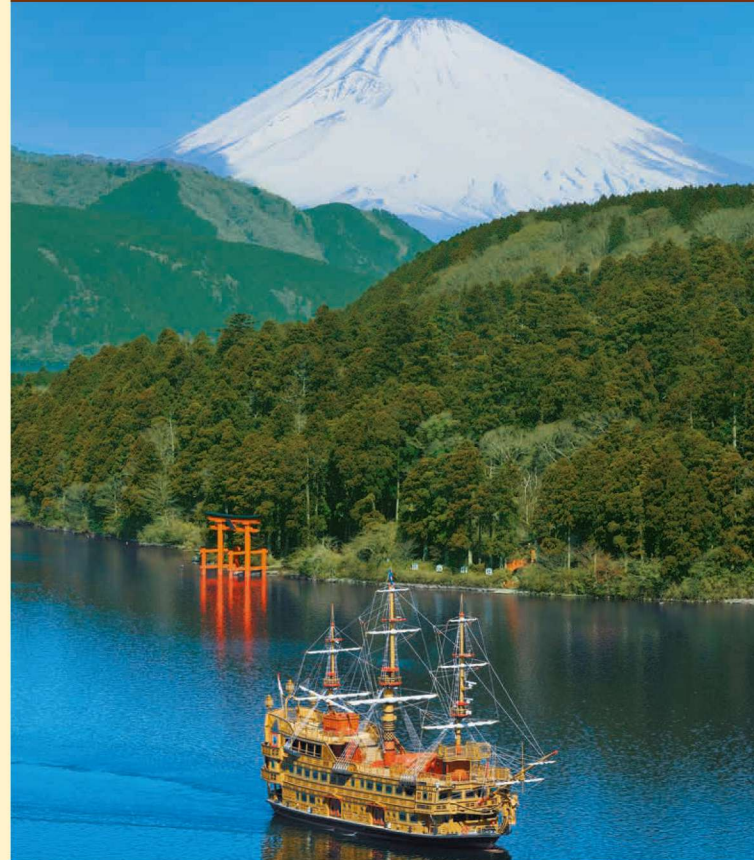

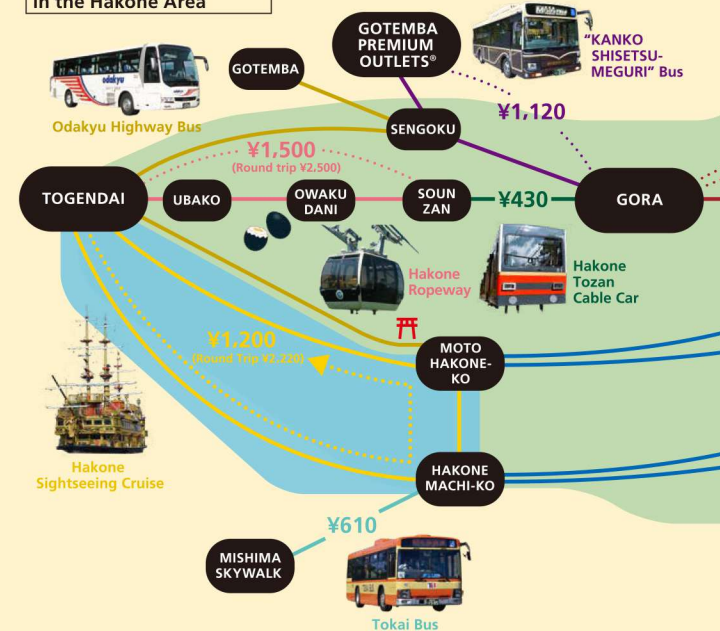

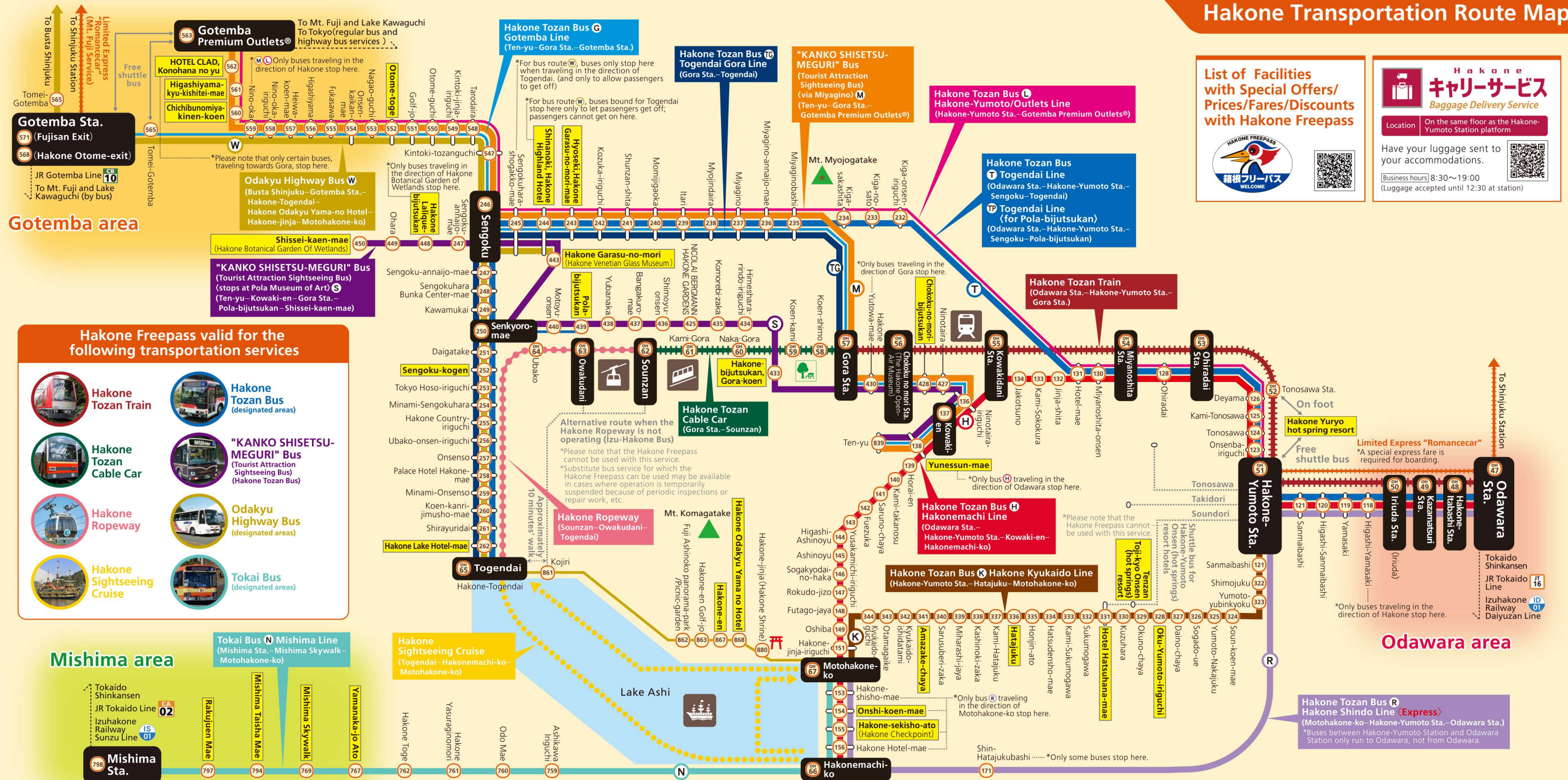
