Amendments to Fares and Prices for the Hakone Ropeway, the Hakone Sightseeing Cruise, and Discount Passes

Odakyu Hakone Co., Ltd. (Headquarters: Odawara City, Kanagawa Prefecture; President: Hidehiro Mizukami) submitted a notice to the Kanto District Transport Bureau of the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism of fare amendment for its ropeway and shipping businesses on Thursday June 19, 2025. Amended fares for the Hakone Ropeway and the Hakone Sightseeing Cruise will go into effect on Wednesday, October 1, 2025. Prices for discounted passes will be amended at the same time.

Reasons for and description of fare amendments are detailed below.

We will continue making every effort to enhance the appeal of Hakone area tourism and look forward to customers' cooperation and understanding.

Details

1. Reasons for Fare Amendment

In keeping with Odakyu Hakone Co., Ltd.'s mission of providing enjoyable recreation, the company works to improve touring in the Hakone area using a variety of transportation modes along the so-called Hakone Golden Route. While business performance is recovering since travel restrictions imposed during the COVID-19 pandemic were lifted, rising prices, labor shortages, and other issues are expected to persist over the long term. These circumstances, together with measures taken to maintain and improve safety given the ever-present risk of natural disasters, and capital improvements to ensure the sustained appeal of tourism in and around Hakone, make it necessary for us to amend fares.

2. Effective Date

The changes below will take effect on Wednesday, October 1, 2025.

3. Description of Changes

(1) Normal passenger fares

① Hakone Ropeway (Sounzan Station–Owakudani Station–Ubako Station–Togendai Station: Single price for the route)

(2) Group fares

Fares for the Hakone Ropeway and the Hakone Sightseeing Cruise remain unchanged, but group size requirements for the Hakone Ropeway will change, from 15 or more persons to 25 or more persons per group.

① Hakone Freepass (departing from Odawara, Hakone area [Hakone-Yumoto, etc.], Gotemba or Mishima)

- Amended fares for the ropeway and cruise and discount passes, etc. apply to both physical and digital tickets sold at stations and other outlets.
- The amended fare for the Hakone Freepass also applies to the Hakone Freepass “Hako Ticket” Plus digital-only ticket.
- Tickets purchased prior to October 1 valid for dates after that date can be used for the current price even after October 1.
