
## Information for Hakone Daimyo Gyoretsu Procession

The Hakone Daimyo Gyoretsu Procession is planned to commence on November 3rd. The head of the parade is scheduled to pass in front of Hakone-Yumoto Station at around 2:00 pm. After the parade has passed, it is expected that the area around the station will become very crowded with passengers. To ensure the safety of passengers, restrictions will be placed on traffic on the sidewalks around the station and entry to the station from 1:30 pm. We ask for your understanding and cooperation.

## 2. Restrictions on entry into the station

Hakone-Yumoto Station is dangerous if many customers enter at once. <u>Please note that we may restrict entry into the station from 1:30 pm.</u> Depending on the situation, it may take a long time to board the train to Odawara. In general, entry to the platform becomes relatively smooth around 3:30 pm Customers who have time are encouraged to take their time sightseeing.

\*\*Bus Information: Due to traffic restrictions, from 1:55 pm to 2:40 pm, you can not get on or off at <a href="Hakone-Yumoto">Hakone-Yumoto</a> and <a href="Onsenba-iriguchi">Onsenba-iriguchi</a> bus stops. When traffic restrictions are in place, buses bound for Odawara direction will leave from <a href="Sanmaibashi">Sanmaibashi</a>. Buses bound for Miyanoshita direction will leave from <a href="Tonosawa">Tonosawa</a>.
